The following resolutions were made regarding the setting of the benchmarks of academic activities:

1. Benchmark of classes to be engaged

All the heads of the academic departments are advised to ensure 100% of the scheduled classes to be engaged in each semester but not below than 85% under exceptional circumstances/happenings.

2. Benchmark of Test/Quiz/ Assignments etc

The number of assignment/quiz/test to be conducted should not be less than four excluding the mid semester examinations. The heads of the departments/faculty concerned should maintain the proper record of assignment/quiz/test for the purpose of accreditation by NAAC, NBA, and ISO like institutions.

3. Feedback Forms

The students and their parents are required to submit feedback forms duly filled online for onward submission to IQAC. Admit cards are to be issued only after submission of online feedback forms.

4. Student Data Base

There should be a common/centralised student data base to avoid any discrepancy between registration, enrolment, admission and award list.

5. Annual Report/Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR)

- (a) Annual Report/Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) to be prepared as per the academic year i.e. 01 Aug. to 31 July
- (b) It will include department wise academic improvement, if any

(c) Proper information to be maintained by each department regarding the students going to higher studies.

One/two days Training workshop to be organised during 1st week of October in order to educate all faculty members regarding academic quality and standards.

7. Departmental coordinator for IQAC

All the academic departments including T & P are advised to nominate coordinator to provide necessary information to IQAC from time to time.

8. Website

It is proposed to have IQAC website for getting feedback from the students, communication with different departments, providing online academic records required by IQAC by different departments. This will help in maintaining data efficiently, timely, accurately without any duplicacy and delay. Each department will be provided a login on IQAC website to upload academic information online. The performance guidelines, AQAR etc will also be available in IQAC website.
